

ERA4212 Environmental law

2 ECTS

Introduction & Objectives

This learning activity is part of the EU ERA421-Foundations And Regulations Of Sustainable Development (5.0 ECTS credits).

The objective of the course is to give students an understanding of the EU legal framework concerning environmental issues as well as responses given at European level.

Learning content

The course will be divided into 3 modules:

- in the first module, we will examine the main sources of EU law and the main principles regulating EU environmental law
- in the second module, we will look at the legal instruments used to adopt EU environmental law
- in the third module, we will look more concretely on how EU environmental law is adopted and by whom.

Learning Outcome

By the end of this module, the students must be able to:

- Define and use the basic terminology related to EU environmental law ;
- Identify the legal framework in which EU environmental law is adopted;
- Understand the role of various actors and institutions in adopting EU environmental law.
